Dear Taxpayers, Residents, and Customers:

The City will be repaving Whitehall Rd. from M120/Causeway to the Bear Creek Bridge. This project is undertaken with a grant from the State of Michigan and local infrastructure money. City Council is committed to restoring North Muskegon's assets in a logical, systematic method.

Prien & Newhof of Muskegon, MI is the engineering firm providing the professional services for the project. Design, surveying, traffic engineering and permitting services are complete. During construction, they will provide staking, inspection, and construction engineering services.

We anticipate the project to begin the last week of July 2019. To protect the construction workers and maintain two lanes of traffic throughout heavy traffic times, work will be conducted in the evenings beginning at 7 p.m. and lasting until 6:00 a.m. Access to driveways and parking lots will be maintained throughout the project. The Contractor does not anticipate working on weekends, unless weather becomes a factor. The project is to be substantially complete no later than September 6, 2019.
