

Millage Rates - 2000 thru 2018

Posted below is a chart that will show you how the millage rates have changed over the past 18 years. While it is worth noting that from 2008 - 2013 the millage rate did not change, the years of 2014, 2015 & 2016 all saw the overall millage rate INCREASE. With the exception of the Reeths Puffer Debt millage - **the other increases in 2014 and 2016 have been the result of ballot proposals being approved by voters.**

For 2018 - there was an overall DECREASE of 1.08892 mills this year. Listed below are all the changes that resulted in the net decrease:

- Laketon Twp operating millage went **down .00292**
- Laketon Twp public safety millage went **down .43600**
- Reeths Puffer Schools debt millage went **down .6500**

The chart below has columns for summer millage, winter millage (with and without PRE - Principal Residence Exemption: formerly called Homestead Exemption) and then the totals for the year. There is also a "Notes/Comments" column that summarizes the changes for that year.
