The Muskegon County Road Commission in cooperation with the Michigan Department of Transportation has scheduled a road improvement project on **River Road from Peterson Road to Buys Road** in Laketon and Fruitland Townships, Muskegon County

The contractor has informed the Road Commission that work should begin April 16, 2018 with 30 work days allowed for construction. The project will consist of 1.51 miles of hot mix asphalt (HMA) base crushing, shaping and resurfacing, including aggregate shoulders, concrete curb and gutter, and pavement marking work and all together with necessary related work.

For safety and overall speed of project completion, the road will be closed during construction. It is, however, a condition of the contract that emergency vehicles and residents living within the construction area are able to get to and from their homes. The posted detour will consist of Buys Road, Giles Road and Simonelli Road.

If you have any critical health condition or other special condition, which you feel we should be made aware of, please feel free to contact the Muskegon County Road Commission.

Notice to those property owners with a concrete driveway approach within the road right-of-way: Be advised that the Muskegon County Road Commission will replace concrete approaches disturbed by construction with hot mix asphalt. If you wish to replace your driveway approach with concrete, you may do so at your expense. Please communicate with our office or our inspector for details on this.

If we need to temporarily relocate your mailbox during the project our inspector will let you know the location where your mail can be picked up.

We are hoping this letter will allow you time to prepare for this upcoming project and plan for any particular needs/concerns you may have.
