ACCEPTED ITEMS / MATERIALS:

- Scrap metals— PLEASE load scrap metals so they are on top or easily accessible –including old grills, lawn mowers, snow blowers & automotive parts without fluids, washing machines, dryers, stainless steel, bike frames, fire grates, bed frames, outdoor furniture, wire shelving, file cabinets, fencing, pipe, wire, old tire rims—**NO TIRES**—see tire event info on reverse side.
- Furniture, mattresses, lamps, desks, tables etc
- **EMPTY Paint cans**—must be open with any remaining paint completely dried up. **NO liquid paint will be accepted.**
- **Misc. household junk**, outdoor toys, playground equipment, broken lawn/yard ornaments, garden hoses, shelving, toys, tools etc
- **Scrap/junk building materials/lumber (NO roofing materials, cement, bricks/blocks)**
- **Scrap household remodeling materials;** toilets, tubs, cabinets, windows, doors, carpet, rugs, carpet padding & other scrap flooring etc.

You MUST bag or box up smaller items —NO LOOSE TRASH/JUNK.

Materials that CANNOT be accepted:

- **NO hazardous waste** pesticides, herbicides, insecticides, fertilizers, poisons, pool chemicals, antifreeze, petroleum products, automotive fluids, wood stains, cleaning products, paint thinner, adhesives, aerosols, fluorescent light bulbs, batteries, drain cleaners—these can be taken to the Muskegon County Public Works Household Hazardous Waste call 231-724-6001 option 4 for more info
- **NO appliances containing mercury**
- **NO roofing materials**
- **NO cement, cement blocks, asphalt, bricks etc**
- **NO hot tubs**
- **NO used motor oil**—FREE recycling available at many automotive retailers.
- **NO tires**—see reverse side for tire recycling info.
- **NO yard waste** please take this to the yard waste site—which will be open 10 AM to 7 PM — \$15.00 annual card required.
- **Please Recycle the following materials: cement, brick, cardboard, electronics, & plastics like garden pots: call for recycling options/events/locations!**
