

SUMMER TAX DEFERMENT INFORMATION:

Summer Tax Deferment....If your household income is less than \$40,000 per year AND you meet ONE of the following, you may qualify to defer your summer taxes:

1. be 62 years of age or older or be the unmarried surviving spouse of a person who was 62 years of age or older at the time of death
2. be paraplegic, hemiplegic, or quadriplegic
3. be an eligible serviceperson, eligible veteran, eligible widow or widower
4. be a blind person
5. be totally, and permanently disabled

If you qualify, you must complete & turn in the appropriate paperwork **no later than the summer tax due date**. The deferment, if granted, pushes back the due date of the summer tax bill, without interest or penalty, to the winter tax due date of February 14th. If you fail to pay by the winter due date after a deferment has been granted, interest/penalty will be charged.
